The new consortia structure is in place and the Minnesota state plan for CTE is available at the MnSCU website <http://www.cte.mnscu.edu/> as is the Programs of Study (POS) chart and other information that may assist you at the local level as you build programs that provide opportunities for students. This year MDE and MnSCU are working on a pilot project that will further the development of pathways within POS. Business and IT are

areas in the pilot this will offer a chance for collaboration and conversation between secondary and post secondary instructors in these areas.

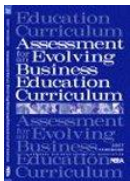
